














Learning in Year 5 this term:

English		Throughout the Summer Term, Year 5 will be exploring 'The Boy who Harnessed the Wind' by William Kamkwamba and Bryan Mealer; 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo and 'The Wonder Brothers' by Frank Cottrell Boyce.
Maths		Within maths, we will be furthering our knowledge on decimals, understanding negative numbers, converting units and exploring volume.
Science		Our science unit will be led by the enquiry question 'what is a force and how does it impact the way things move?'.
Computing		In computing, we will be creating media using vector graphics followed by a continuation of our programming unit.
History		Within history, we will be led by the enquiry question 'how did Britain change between the end of the Roman occupation and 1006?'. Our local history week will explore what life was like for a child worker in a Lancashire mill.
Geography		Our geography unit will be led by the enquiry question 'how did Blackpool grow to become one of the UK's favourite seaside resorts?'.
Art		In art we will be drawing, exploring retrofuturism.
DT		Our DT unit looks into designing and building bridges.
PE		In indoor PE we will cover gymnastics and athletics. In outdoor PE we will cover rugby and rounders.
PSHE		Our PSHE units explore relationships and our changing selves.
RE		Our RE focuses will be the Christian church and Judaism.
Music		In music, 5OB and 5OF will be studying musical theatre and 5B will be learning to play the ukelele.
French		Our French topic will look into verbs used within a week.
