Reminders

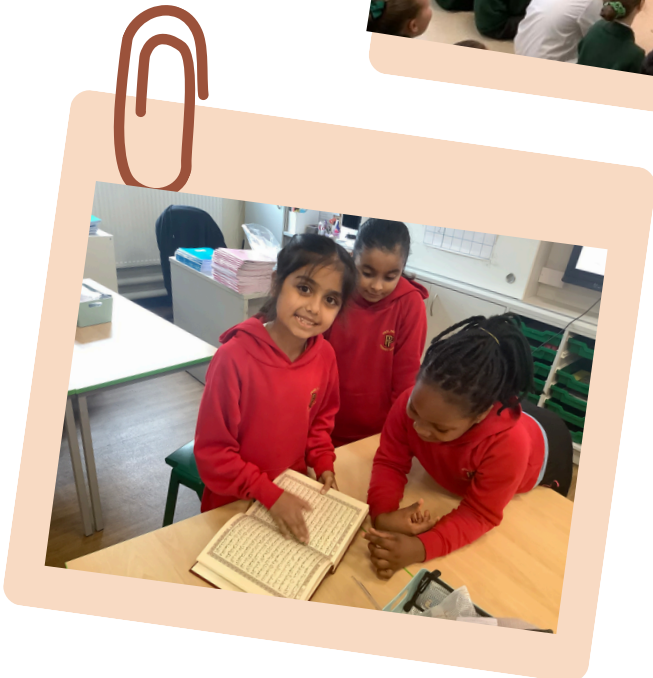
- HOMEWORK AND SPELLINGS ARE GIVEN OUT EVERY FRIDAY.

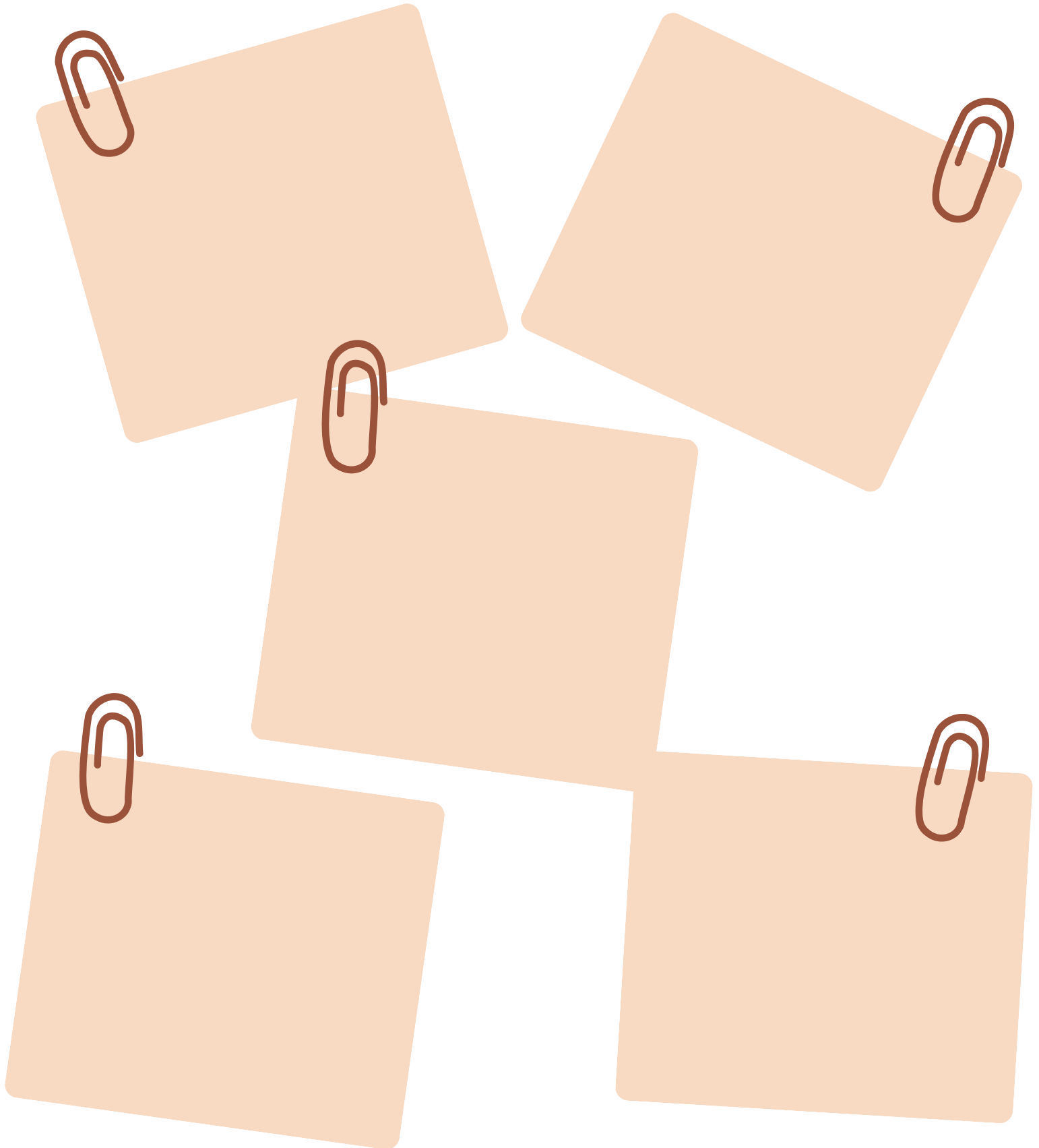
