## Look What We Learned

### MATHS MASTERS

This term, Year 1 have been exploring place value by working with numbers within 50. They have also been learning the multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and learning about measurements, with a focus on length and height.

### ENGLISH EXPLORERS

In English, the children have been learning all about poetry and the key features, exploring poems with a winter theme. They have also been looking at the text, 'Lost in the Toy Museum: an adventure,' and having been writing a diary and a report based on this.

### SUPER SCIENTISTS

In science, the children have been learning about different animals, focusing on a new group each week. They have also explored the characteristics of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



## What's New

The children have thoroughly enjoyed taking part in PE this half term, particularly their dance sessions with Sophie. The theme has been animals, which links nicely with the Year 1 science unit. They have been learning a dance inspired by The Lion King to the song, "I Just Can't Wait to Be King."
