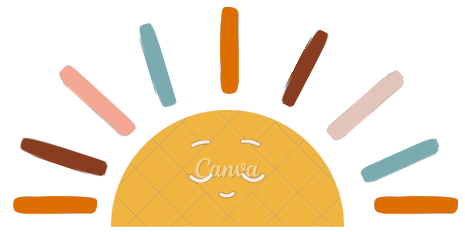

Look What We Learned

MATHS MASTERS

This term, Year 2 have explored multiplication and division through learning to group and share. We explored making equal groups and using the multiplication symbol to form equations. We also began to look at measurement, looking at length and height, taking a deep look at how to use a ruler accurately and a meter stick or tape.

ENGLISH EXPLORERS

In English, we explored a book by Oliver Jeffers, looking in depth at setting descriptions. We included all the features: time of day, what the weather is like, what we could smell, hear, see and touch. After that, we used the book to write persuasive leaflets, using persuasive quotes, catchy slogans and introductions. We have persuaded Year 3 to visit a wonder of the world. We enjoyed the process of researching each place and choosing the one we wanted to write about. Our writing is improving because we follow the success criteria, we know how to form interesting sentences and our stamina for writing is better.

SUPER SCIENTISTS

In Science, we have investigated what plants need to grow. We have designed an experiment to find out what a healthy plant would need. We researched different types of plants and found out the differences between plants and trees.

In Geography we have been looking closely at maps, looking at significant landmarks across the world. We now know the names of the oceans that cover the surface of our planet.
