Look What We Learned

Brilliant Biologists

In Science, we have been learning about the circulatory system and exploring how the heart works, how blood travels and the role of different components. A highlight of the term was creating their own 'blood', where they represented red blood cells, white blood cells and platelets. This hands-on learning really helped to deepen their understanding of how the system functions.

Message Makers– Speaking from the Heart

In English, we have been immersed in our class text *Pig Heart Boy*. The children have explored themes of identity, ethics and decision-making, which has inspired some thoughtful discussions. Using this as a stimulus, they have written and recorded their own video letters, demonstrating strong use of persuasive language, emotive vocabulary and clear structure. It has been fantastic to see their confidence grow both in writing and speaking.

Maths Masters

This term, Year 6 have developed their knowledge, skill and confidence in working with decimals, fractions and percentages. They have been calculating, reasoning and solving a range of problems, applying their learning in different contexts. More recently, the children have begun exploring statistics, interpreting and presenting data using a variety of graphs and charts. Their ability to explain their thinking and justify their answers has been particularly impressive.



Broadening Horizons

Across the wider curriculum, Year 6 have explored energy sources in Geography while developing their use of six-figure grid references. In DT, they designed and built their own playgrounds, applying their knowledge of structures. In P.E. and French, they have developed their gymnastics skills and learned to describe where they live!
